- 1,820 police (including 1,400 formed units personnel, 400 individual police officers and 20 corrections officers)
- An appropriate significant civilian component

Current Authorization [resolution 2212](#) of 26 March 2015]

- 12,870 total uniformed personnel, including:
- 10,750 military personnel (including 240 military observers and 200 staff officers)
- 2,120 police (including 1,400 formed units personnel, 680 individual police officers and 40 corrections officers)
- An appropriate significant civilian component

Current strength (31 March 2016)

- 11,846 total uniformed personnel
- 9,799 military personnel
- 1,896 police (including formed units)
- 151 military observers
- 518 international civilian personnel
- 242 local civilian staff
- 184 United Nations Volunteers
